Mr. HURD of Colorado introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Natural Resources

A BILL

To prohibit the Secretary of the Interior from taking any action to expand the Mid-Continent Limestone Quarry located near Glenwood Springs, Colorado.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Glenwood Hot Springs
5 Protection Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON EXPANSION OF THE MID-CON-**
7 **TINENT LIMESTONE QUARRY.**

8 The Secretary of the Interior shall not process or ap-
9 prove any application for the expansion of existing mineral

1 operations located on any mining or mill site claim located
2 under the general mining laws, or for any mineral material
3 sales contract or application under the Act of July 31,
4 1947 (commonly known as the “Materials Act of 1947”)
5 (61 Stat. 681, chapter 406; 30 U.S.C. 601 et seq.), or
6 the Act of July 23, 1955 (commonly known as the “Sur-
7 face Resources Act of 1955”) (69 Stat. 367, chapter 375;
8 30 U.S.C. 611 et seq.), for limestone on land managed
9 by the Bureau of Land Management that is located in
10 whole or in part within the area described as T. 6 S., R.
11 89 W., Section 4, T. 5 S., R. 89 W., Sections 25 and
12 36, and T. 5 S., R. 88 W., Sections 30 and 31, sixth prin-
13 cipal meridian, in Garfield County, Colorado.

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
